## MDPA Community Teams

In his report at the Annual General Meeting the association president referred to the many community teams that make up the fabric of the organisation and work tirelessly to give back to the Moonta community. Over the past decade the population of Moonta and Port Hughes has increased very significantly with many choosing to make the area central to their retirement lifestyle. A significant part of that lifestyle is due to the effort of community volunteers who work behind the scenes to organise and to raise funds with the many events which enhance the quality of life on the Copper Coast. We look forward to welcoming new members and volunteers in the future. An outline of the work of the various teams follows:

### Christmas Pageant

A highlight of the Christmas festivities in Moonta is the annual Christmas Pageant, a procession of floats which make their way down the main street to finish at Queen Square. This year's pageant will start at Military Road, travel to Blanche Terrace, down to William St and on to finish at Queen Square. Father Christmas will follow the procession and will greet children in the square. There will be live music, free face painting and a twilight market followed by carols in Queen Square. ### Community Activity Centre (Men's Shed and Mosaics Group)

The CAC offers well equipped workshops where a wide variety of wood and metal working projects are undertaken. The recently formed Mosaics Group has proved to be extremely popular, again with a wide variety of projects undertaken.

### Friends of Victoria Park

As the name suggests, Victoria Park is a parklands area to the south of Moonta which was established in the early days of the Moonta township as a recreational space for the townsfolk. The park covers several acres of native vegetation and the work of the dedicated group of 'Friends' who meet each week is primarily devoted to the upkeep of plants and pathways and the removal of feral vegetation.

### McCauley Park Volunteers

McCauley Park lies to the west of the town and comprises several acres of open parkland, wetlands and native vegetation. In recent years a devoted team has worked to restore the park to its former glory. There has also been considerable input from the Copper Coast Council.

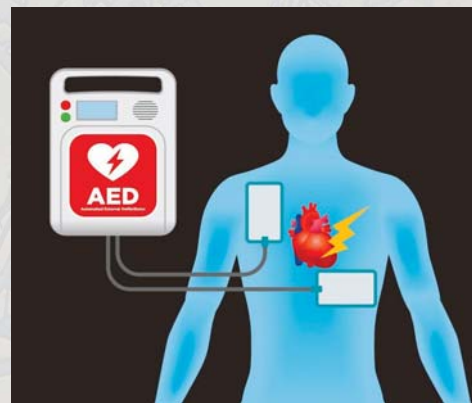
### Town Beautification

### AEDs, or Automated External Defibrillators

An AED, or Automated External Defibrillator, is a portable device that can be used by anyone to deliver an electrical shock to a person in sudden cardiac arrest to help restart their heart. By providing voice or visual prompts, the device guides users through the process, making it a critical tool for improving survival chances in emergencies. When someone experiences a sudden cardiac arrest, their heart's electrical activity becomes chaotic and ineffective, meaning it can't pump blood. An AED automatically analyzes the heart's rhythm to determine if an electrical shock is needed.



If a shock is required, the AED delivers one to stop the heart's chaotic activity, giving the heart a chance to return to a normal rhythm and pump blood again. AEDs are designed to be used by laypeople without any prior training. Voice and visual cues guide the user on what to do. If a person is unresponsive and not breathing normally, you should dial emergency services (like 000 in Australia) and begin CPR. As soon as an AED is available, use it in conjunction with chest compressions to increase the chances of survival. AEDs are located in many public places. Many local ambulance services and health organizations have online AED registry maps that show the locations of defibrillators near you. There are a number of phone apps that map the locations of AEDs. However, these are not always up to date and may therefore be inaccurate

### Men's Shed And Kindergarten Project

The Moonta Kindergarten approached the Men's Shed to build them a Mud Kitchen. Measurements were taken and members of the Men's Shed proceeded to build the kitchen. The members of the Men's Shed had a lot of fun and interest in the building of the kitchen for the local children to enjoy. It was transported and erected.

A decision was made by members of the Men's Shed to donate the mud kitchen to the Moonta Kindergarten.

## One Wheel On My Wagon

### A Cautionary Tale

A friend was recently returning from a holiday trip to Whyalla with caravan in tow.

Travelling down the main highway a little

north of Port Germain he was horrified when one of the caravan wheels became completely detached, the van dragging drunkenly along the road on one wheel and one brake drum, accompanied by showers of sparks and the demented screeching of tortured metal. Fortunately damage to the van was very minor, and it was taken to Port Pirie for repair. In discussion with the repairer my friend learned that the wheel studs on caravan wheels, especially 'mags', have a nasty habit of working themselves loose—which was what had happened in this instance. My friend was fortunate that when the wheel came adrift the caravan had continued to travel in a straight line and had not slewed into oncoming traffic or the outcome could have been very much more serious.

The moral of the story—check that the wheel studs on your caravan are all correctly tensioned before embarking on a journey.

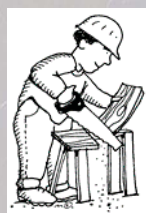
